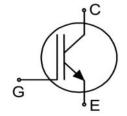

Further Electrical Characteristics

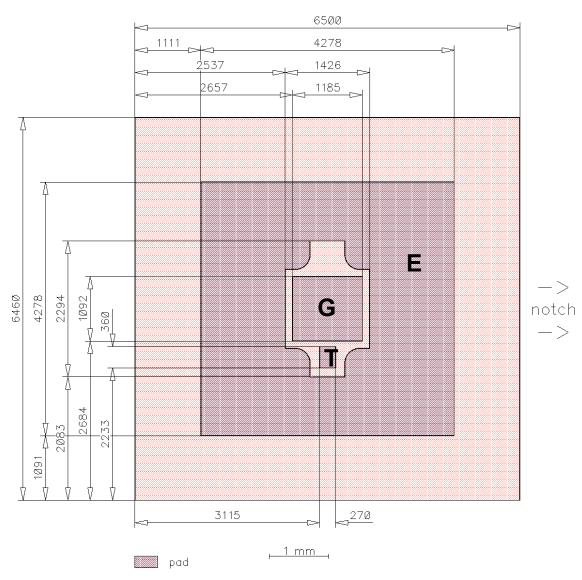
Switching characteristics and thermal properties are depending strongly on module design and mounting technology and can therefore not be specified for a bare die.
